Introduction and Purpose

Core Values and Principles

Expected Behaviours and Conduct

As a parent/carer, we expect you to:

- Support the school's policies, procedures, and decisions, and work collaboratively with staff to address any concerns.
- Refrain from using inappropriate or offensive language, either in person or through any form of communication.
- Avoid confrontational or aggressive behaviour, and instead, seek to resolve issues through open and constructive dialogue.
- Respect the school's property and facilities, and ensure your child does the same.
- Uphold the school's commitment to sustainability, diversity, and community engagement.

Communication Guidelines

Effective communication is essential for a successful partnership between home and school. We encourage you to:

- Maintain open and regular communication with your child's teacher and the school leadership team.
- Respond promptly to any requests for information or feedback from the school.
- Refrain from using social media or other platforms to air grievances or make negative comments about the school, its staff, or other members of the community.
- Respect the privacy and confidentiality of all individuals within the school community.

Responsibilities as a Parent/Carer

As a parent/carer, you play a crucial role in supporting your child's education and the overall success of the school. We expect you to:

- Ensure your child attends school regularly, on time, and is ready to learn.
- Support your child's learning by encouraging them, checking their homework, and providing a suitable environment for study.

- Attend parent-teacher meetings and other school events to stay informed and engaged with your child's education.
- Volunteer or contribute to the school community in ways that align with your skills and interests.
- Inform the school of any changes in your child's circumstances or needs that may affect their wellbeing or learning.

Consequences for Non-Compliance
