Dear Parents

As we have indicated in previous communication, we are planning to start introducing morning Teams meetings with our classes starting next week. As a reminder, Rye and Ouse class will have their meetings on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays and Derwent and Foss Classes will have their meetings on Tuesdays and Thursdays. We hope that the children will really enjoy interacting with their friends, sharing work and what they have been doing and feeling together again, albeit virtually.

We appreciate that this is another ask of parents but I do know that other schools who are organising these have had very positive feedback. This will also provide another opportunity for teachers to explain the work and offer some teaching points.

As we set this up, it is more than likely that we might encounter some technical hitches although we hope they will be minimal!

Class teachers will send out a link for the meetings. Some of you who run Office 365 at home, might have the Teams App already downloaded. Please do use this option if you have it. However, the Teams meeting can be accessed via the web browser without the need to have the App installed on your device. From our experience, we have found that this works best with more recent versions of Windows. Next week as we start the sessions, we will use them just to say hello and hopefully try to sort out any technical issues. We do understand if you are not always able to facilitate your child being part of these sessions due to your own work commitments, but we do hope as many children as possible will be able to join in. Class teachers will be sending out links for meetings in due course and this will be sent to the email we are currently using to send home learning. Children in school, will not need a link as they will take part in the meeting in the classroom.

Thank you all for your continued support. I will be contacting you all for feedback as to how things are going. I totally appreciate what a challenge it is to be delivering learning at home. We hope you find the resources we are sending out accessible. As we try to minimise risk for our school community, some members of staff will be working either at home or school on a rota basis. This will not affect the provision in school or for those at home. As always, please do feel free to contact me if you feel I can help in any way.
