Christmas Arrangements!

We are all enjoying the run up to Christmas in school. Class 1 and Year 2 are busy rehearsing for their performances next week of "Born in a Barn". Class 2 will be visiting the Hope Central Christmas Experience next Thursday, and Class 3 will shortly start practising for their roles in our school carol concert on Thursday 20th December (at 9.15am).

Sam is currently allocating tickets for Born in a Barn based on the request slips that we have received. In order to help her with this, please can you make sure that all requests for tickets have been sent into school **by tomorrow**. We will be sending tickets home on Friday in envelopes so please look out for them in children's bags.
