### E.Y.F.S and Key Stage one visit to Howsham Mill on Monday 1<sup>st</sup> July 2019

On **Monday 1<sup>st</sup> July Derwent and Foss class** are going on a visit to Howsham Mill. The coach will depart from Langton at 9:20am; and we are expecting to return by the end of the school day. Your child will need to bring a **packed lunch** and a water bottle. As we will be outdoors for the majority of the day and the conditions surrounding the mill are wood and meadowland, it is essential that we all have covered legs (trousers or leggings) not shorts and skirts; with school shirts and hoodies. **Rain coats** and wellingtons, boots or outdoor trainers are a must as we will need to walk to and from different areas. Sun cream and hats are advised dependent on the weather.

The purpose of our visit is to address many outdoor learning and forest schools opportunities for learning. As well as looking at local history in our community and science objectives for E.Y.F.S and K.S 1, we are sure to have lots of fun! We have arranged for the education officer at the mill to lead us in bread making and baking. She will also provide us with materials for den building and we ourselves will facilitate a minibeast/flora and fauna hunt and also complete some observational drawings.

Due to a generous contribution from FOLS there will be no charge for his visit as the transport costs have been met. **We ask for you to give your permission for your child to attend and your emergency contact details for the day via ParentPay.** We would appreciate greatly, any family members (over 18's) who would be available to help supervise children on our visit. Please see either Mrs Laverack or Mrs Cummings if you are available. For this trip to go ahead, we need a number of volunteer helpers as the legal ratio for young children is 1:4.
