Ouse Class trip to the National Coal Mining Museum – Tuesday 7th May 2019

As part of our topic 'This is Yorkshire!' Ouse class have been looking at different jobs held by people in the local area and how people get to work. After the Easter Holidays, we will continue this topic and focus our learning on coal mining, a very popular job in Yorkshire throughout history.
