I am writing to invite you to our Open Evening so that you can see for yourselves what Malton School has to offer.

For Year 6 parents I know that the coming month is an important time for you in making the choice of secondary school for your child. We have arranged our Open Evening at what I hope is a helpful time for you. There will be a presentation at 6.30pm in the Main Hall (West Wing) given by senior pastoral staff, including an address from myself. There will then be a chance to visit all the Departments of the school to see (and participate in!) a selection of their work. You and your child will be able to ask questions to a wide range of staff and current students to get a flavour of life at Malton School. Information will be available about our iPad for Learning scheme and our extended day in which we deliver a wide range of personal skill development activities.

I am also aware that many Year 5 parents will be looking a year ahead to the decision they will have to make. You are very welcome to attend our event if it would be helpful for you at this stage.

We have had quite a number of requests for visits during the school day as well. If you have any doubts over your choice and would like to see the school in operation on a normal day please contact Miss Davison, Head of Lower School or Mrs Beal, Assistant Head of Lower School, to arrange a visit. We would ask that such requests are limited to Year 6 parents only over the next month running up to the North Yorkshire County Council deadline for return of school application forms on 31 October 2019.

In addition to the free transport offered by North Yorkshire County Council to families in our catchment area, Malton School also provides transport serving out of catchment areas. There are currently eight different routes, these serve:

- The A64 corridor to Filey, Cayton and Wintringham (3 separate routes)
- The B1253 to Sledmere
- The villages around Flaxton to Huby
- The A170 corridor and south of Pickering
- The villages around Langton and Claxton (2 separate routes)

I do hope you will consider Malton School as the right choice for your child and I look forward to meeting you in the near future.
