Sponsored Walkie Talkie Welly Walk – Tuesday 15th October 2019

We will be holding our Annual Sponsored Welly Walk on the afternoon of **Tuesday 15th October**. Not only is this a great opportunity to raise money for our School Fund, but to also get out and about into the beautiful surroundings of the Langton Estate and enjoy the Autumn air. Jennie Johnson, mum of Jasper in Year 4, is helping to organise the event, which this year will have a Walkie Talkie theme. We are linking our Walk this year to the work we have been doing around Mindfulness. This Thursday is World Mental Health Day so our Walkie Talkie theme is highlighting the importance of talking about things which may worry us rather than keeping them inside. The children will find green ribbons and balloons along the route to remind them of this. Our thanks also to Mrs Howard-Vyse for enabling us to use the land again this year.

This is a sponsored event for school funds, and you will find your child’s Sponsor Form on the back of this letter. A big thank you to Mrs Sam Read (Olivia’s Mum) who has been able to secure a Castle Howard Family Pass as a prize for collecting sponsors. The Pass is valid until 5th November 2019 so perfect for a Half Term visit to Skelf Island!
